

## BTE – San Lorenzo Program Model

**Target Population:** 35-50 rising 10<sup>th</sup> graders enrolled at Jose Campeche High School in School Year 2015-2016, that had been enrolled in 9<sup>th</sup> grade in a pipeline school during Year 2014-2015, with an overall 9<sup>th</sup> grade GPA between 1.69 to 3.0 OR a Basic / Pre-Basic 8<sup>th</sup> Grade standardized test score in Science and Math.
