



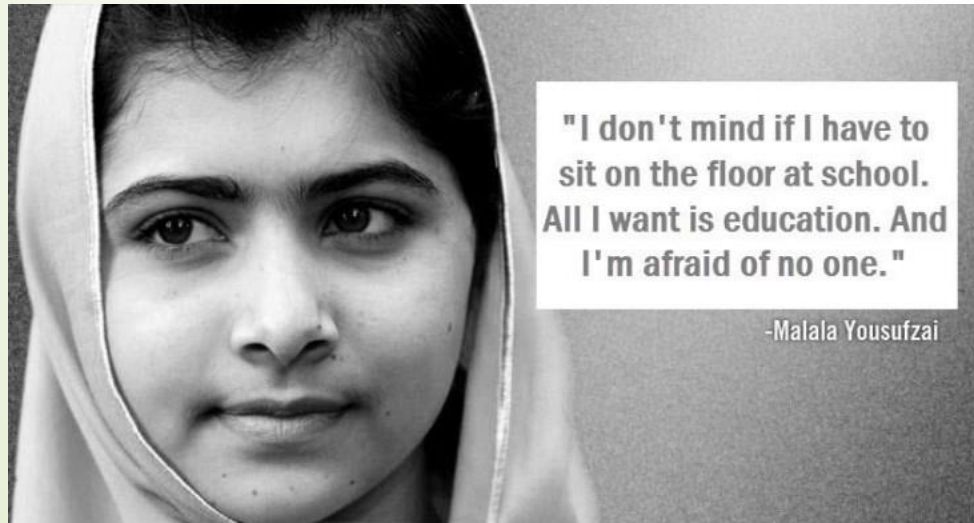

- Compulsory education in Indonesia consists of grades 1-9.
- 25% of children at primary level are over-age as indicated by the large gross enrollment percentage.
