**Target Population:** 50 Grade 9 students attending Cedar Shoals High School in School Year 2018-2019 who meet the following criteria: 1) passing 6:7 courses, including all core classes; 2) fewer than 10% unexpected absences; and 3) no major / violent disciplinary infractions
