DAY 2: TUESDAY, AUGUST 30, 2022

TIME	SESSION
7:00-7:30 AM EDT	LANGUAGE LINGO Responding to ambassadors' global requests to learn about each other's cultures and languages, Language Lingo sessions are designed for ambassadors to teach (and learn) about each other's local greetings and pleasantries. Ambassadors will be challenged to use their new learnings throughout their ABTS experience.
7:30-8:30 AM EDT	BTE BATTLE OF THE BEST A modern-day twist on a Socratic Seminar, this session will bring together BTE alumni from across the globe who will share their experiences, words of wisdom, and tips for success with Student Ambassadors, who will lead this session as moderators. In the spirit of games, both alumni panelists and student ambassadors will set their virtual backgrounds to their favorite sports team. The twist? FHI 360 will referee (quite literally) and red card any alumni or ambassador who uses the buzzword "BTE". The team (alumni v. ambassadors) who is carded the most will face the ultimate "penalty" and create a BTE rap that will be posted as an Instagram Reel.
8:30-9:30 AM EDT	INTRODUCTION TO THE DESIGN PROCESS Students will be taken through a series of steps that engineers use to guide them in solving problems. Utilizing a design process provides engineers the opportunity to use their innovation and creativity in a structured environment.

10:30-11:30 AM EDT	INSTANT CHALLENGE: MAZE RUNNER Student Ambassadors will engage in their final mini challenge for the week. Ambassadors will be challenged to build a marble maze using their critical thinking, problem-solving, and creativity skills.
11:30AM-12:45 PM EDT	INTRODUCTION TO SIMPLE MACHINES Have you ever looked at something and thought "How does that work?". In this activity, students will be introduced to the six simple machines that make up most of the complex tools used today. Students will participate in an interactive online game and research compound machines that can be broken down into simple machines that are commonly used.

1:00-2:00 PM EDT	WORK, FORCE, AND MECHANICAL ADVANTAGE In this session, students will learn how machines work smarter, not harder. A machine's ability to do work depends on mechanical advantage and efficiency. Students will investigate how mechanical advantages allow humans to perform tasks much easier in terms of the force they need to apply.

DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 31, 2022

7:00-8:00 AM EDT	RESEARCHING YOUR RANGE Teams will work together to conduct research and begin identifying a theme for their mini-golf course. Ambassadors should refer to their ABTS pre-work and BTE 30 Years Top Highlights; they will conduct a virtual scavenger hunt to identify important moments in BTE's history.
8:00-8:45 AM EDT	DESIGN MEETS PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT: LEARNING FROM AN EXPERT Student Ambassadors will be joined by a Johnson & Johnson expert that will discuss the connection between design and product development.

9:00-10:00 AM EDT	INTRODUCTION TO 3D MODELING Students will experiment with 3D modeling to create the layout for their mini golf course hole. Students will learn the basics of TinkerCAD, an easy-to-use 3D CAD design tool to quickly turn their own vision into a virtual reality.
10:00-11:00 AM EDT	WORKING SESSION Student ambassadors will use this time to independently explore TinkerCAD and begin shaping their 3D modeling skills. Ambassadors will be joined by Pathway to Success participants, who will serve as peer advisors and can assist with providing CAD guidance. FHI 360 will conduct check-ins with each team and answer any outstanding questions.

11:30AM-1:00 PM EDT	CULTURAL COMIC Using Canva's new comic strip templates, each student ambassador will be tasked with creating their own BTE storytelling comic strip. Ambassadors will create a comic strip that reflects their local community and cultural and how BTE is partnering to positively impact youth within their community.
1:00-1:45PM	PROTOTYPING 101 Prototyping is a key component in the design process because it allows engineers to test and improve their ideas quickly. In this session, students will be given construct a mini golf course hole using cardboard, tape, and other household items. During this step of the design process, students must also stick to the team's pre-determined theme and incorporate at least two simple machines into their design.
