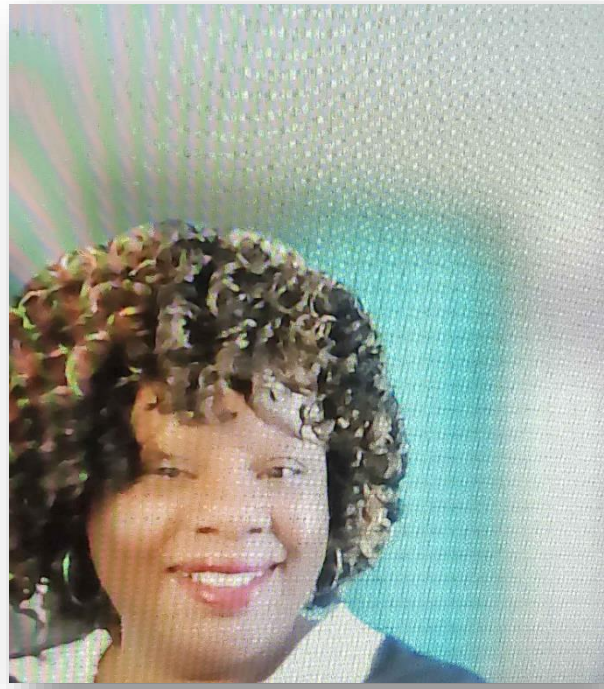

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What is a Partnership?

- A group of organizations working together for a common goal.
- A partnership is strategic when it provides your organization with the means and methods for advancing your mission.



Why Community Partners Are Important

- **Allows the project to run smoothly, it actively enhances the reputation of the organization, and helps to build support of the project.**
- **Central to improving accountability within your own organization, as well as to the wider community.**

Steps to Implementing Partnerships

- **Identify and engage the potential organization**
- **Establish a personal relationship and build trust**
- **Clarify your goals and the objectives each partner wants to accomplish**
- **Choose and implement a partnership that is mutually beneficial**
